Comes now the Plaintiff, V.O., by and through counsel and, pursuant to Federal Rule of Civil

Procedure 41(a)(1)(A)(i), files this voluntary dismissal, stating as follows:

1. On October 12, 2007, Plaintiff filed a Complaint in this case challenging Defendants' denial of official recognition to her student Youth Alive Club at Middlebury Union High School ("MUHS").

2. In her Complaint, Plaintiff alleged that Defendants denied to her rights, benefits, and privileges equal to those received by other members of officially recognized clubs at MUHS.

3. Soon thereafter, on November 2, 2007, Plaintiff filed a Motion for Preliminary Injunction with this Court, requesting an order prohibiting Defendants from discriminating against her and the Youth Alive Club based on the religious content and viewpoint of her intended speech. 4. Plaintiff also asked that this Court order Defendants to provide her with equal access to all of the rights, benefits, and privileges given to other members of officially recognized clubs at MUHS.

5. In January, 2008, Defendants' counsel notified Plaintiff's counsel in writing of Defendants' decision to grant official club status to the Youth Alive Club and to give Plaintiff the same rights, benefits, and privileges as all other members of officially recognized student clubs at MUHS.

6. Plaintiff and her Club have been granted official status and provided such rights, benefits, and privileges.

Defendants have also paid Plaintiff's attorneys' fees pursuant to 42 U.S.C. § 1988.
Based on the above actions of the Defendants, Plaintiff hereby voluntarily dismisses this action without prejudice.
