INTERVENOR-DEFENDANT STATE OF WEST VIRGINIA'S MOTION TO DISMISS

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The State of West Virginia moves this Court for an order dismissing all of the claims asserted in the Complaint, with prejudice. Plaintiffs lack standing to assert claims on behalf of non-party patients whose interests conflict with their own. Plaintiffs also lack standing to assert claims on their own behalf because they fail to allege facts sufficient to plausibly conclude that any injury is traceable to government action, rather than the independent decisions of private parties.

Additionally, the Court should dismiss the Complaint because it fails to state a claim under the Due Process and Equal Protection Clauses of the Fourteenth Amendment. Rational basis

review applies to each claim because Plaintiffs do not invoke any fundamental right or suspect classification. And the challenged law satisfies the deferential requirements of rational basis as a matter of law.

Therefore, for the reasons set forth here and in the Memorandum of Law in Support of Intervenor-Defendant State of West Virginia's Motion to Dismiss, the State respectfully requests that the Court dismiss all claims with prejudice.
